Position Description:

Kennesaw State University Counseling and Psychological Services (CPS) is seeking a full-time, 12-month, counselor with specialized experience working with eating disorders. CPS is a comprehensive counseling service with a multi-disciplinary staff charged with facilitating the mental health and wellness of KSU students. This position leads the Healthy Eating and Living Team (HEAL), that in addition to the eating disorder specialist, is composed of a dietitian and psychiatrist. The goal of the HEAL team is to ensure students with significant body image issues and/or an eating disorders are receiving appropriate on or off-campus care and support. The eating disorder specialist also serves as the primary consultant to other CPS staff when treating a student with an eating disorder.

In addition to coordinating counseling services for students struggling with body image and disordered eating, this position includes providing initial assessments, ongoing short-term individual, group, and couples counseling to KSU students. Some supervision of undergraduate/graduate Social work students may be required. All CPS clinicians engage in crisis assessment and intervention during day-time and after hours on-call as assigned. Attendance at monthly staff and clinical meetings is required. Additional duties include organization and maintenance of HEAL team records, as well as general client records (complete case notes, assessments, tracking forms, release of information forms, referral forms) according to standards of the profession. All CPS staff members contribute to the other areas of Student Success Services as needed and perform other duties as assigned by the Director and Associate Director.

Qualifications: Minimum qualifications include a master's degree in Counseling, Social Work or Psychology preferred. Licensed or License eligible as a counselor, psychologist or social worker a must. Candidates with experience in the field of Eating Disorders (5 years or more) will be given preference.
