Associate Director Counseling Center

Eastern Kentucky University is accepting applications for Associate Director of the Counseling Center. The incumbent assists the Director in administering and directing the overall operation of the Counseling Center, including, but not limited to, addressing clinical priorities, budget, personnel/staffing issues, quality control, mission, vision and strategic planning. Additionally, the Associate Director implements, monitors and oversees all aspects of the clinical services of the Counseling Center. Manages all operations of the Counseling Center in the absence of the Director.

Requirements: Doctoral degree in Counseling, Psychology or related field and five years of post-doctoral experience providing clinical services is required including three years of experience working in a university counseling center post-licensure and three years of experience supervising trainees, post-doctoral staff members and/or licensed mental health providers. Incumbent is required to maintain licensure as a psychologist. Must be a licensed psychologist. Must be eligible for licensure as a psychologist in Kentucky and must become licensed in Kentucky within one year of employment.
