Position Title: Limited Term Staff Therapist

Participate in supervision, if and as needed. Participate in case conference (on a regular basis), staff professional development activities, and departmental staff meetings, as needed. Other duties as assigned, including but not limited to quality improvement activities.

Qualifications:

Required:

- Preference will be given to candidates who possess a Ph.D. or Psy.D. in Clinical or Counseling Psychology from an APA approved program, or an MSW degree.
- Must be certified or licensed (eligible) in the state of Indiana. (Preference will be given to candidates who are immediately licensable in the State of Indiana, or who are already licensed.)
- Consideration will be given to an equivalent combination of related education and required work experience.
- One year of general therapy experience with young adults is required. Pre-doctoral internship may count as one year.
- The successful candidate must be a strong generalist therapist. The candidate must have excellent skills as a clinician (evaluate and diagnose patients, make decisions about urgency of patients' problems, and design and implement appropriate treatment interventions).

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- Understanding of and adherence to professional ethics and laws are mandatory. In all aspects of the job, confidentiality and ethical behavior are essential, as are good judgment and discretion.
- Good communication skills (oral, written), and planning, problem-solving, organizational, and project management skills are necessary.
- Excellent customer service skills and professionalism in dealing with students, staff colleagues, faculty and other members of the University community are necessary.
- Candidate must have an ability to influence and build work relationships among a diverse workforce at all levels.
- Candidate must possess a learning orientation to changing technology impacting psychological and therapy services.
- Personal computer and related software skills necessary.

Preferred:

- Doctorate in Counseling or Clinical Psychology, with appropriate internship, or Master's in Social Work. A Master's degree in Counseling/Clinical Psychology, with licensure and clinical experience, will be considered.
- Experience providing mental health services to the college/university population.
- Candidates who additionally have values around social justice, and interest and experience in multicultural counseling.
