Job Summary: The University Counseling Center (UCC) at The University of Utah welcomes applications for a fully benefitted, 35 hours/week staff psychologist (.875 FTE). This is a six month position (approximately January 16 – July 15, 2015). Responsibilities include providing individual, group and couples counseling to a multicultural college population. A strong ability and interest to engage actively in collaborative outreach partnerships with the University of Utah campus is necessary. The successful candidate will have a demonstrated commitment to working with multicultural programming and diverse populations. In addition, this position actively participates in the training of graduate students and psychology interns. Expertise in crisis intervention and mindfulness-based interventions is desirable.

The UCC is accredited by the International Association of Counseling Services (IACS). We have a multi-disciplinary staff composed of professionals from psychology, social work, clinical mental health counseling, and psychiatry backgrounds. We have a nationally recognized training program that includes an American Psychological Association accredited pre-doctoral internship as well as trainees in Social Work, Psychiatry, Counseling Psychology and Clinical Psychology. The Counseling Center also houses the Center for Student Wellness, Learning Enhancement Program, and the Testing Center. Responsibilities: 1) Provide intake assessments and crisis intervention services; 2) Conduct individual, couples, and group psychotherapy; 3) Provide campus prevention and outreach presentations; 4) Other responsibilities as assigned.

Preferred Qualifications: Applicants must possess a degree from an accredited doctoral program in psychology (Ph.D. in Counseling or Clinical Psychology, Psy.D. or Ed.D.). Must also be licensed or license-eligible in the State of Utah. Excellent clinical skills, demonstrated interest in prevention/outreach, and a strong knowledge base regarding multicultural issues are required.
