Staff Clinician

Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU) seeks a Staff Clinician to join the staff of University Counseling Services in the Division of Student Affairs at our Monroe Park Campus location. General responsibilities include intake assessment, individual psychotherapy, group psychotherapy, crisis work, trainee supervision, outreach and consultation.

Preference will be given to professionals who have an interest and/or experience in substance abuse treatment.

Required Qualifications:

Doctorate degree in Counseling or Clinical Psychology, MSW in Social Work or Master's in Counseling. ABD in psychology also permitted with expectation of completed degree within one year of hire date. Also completion of a supervised APA accredited internship or equivalent work experience. The position requires excellent communication skills, both oral and written, strong interpersonal skills, experience with brief psychotherapy, evidence of multicultural competence, and licensed or license eligible in the Commonwealth of Virginia. Demonstrated experience working in and fostering a diverse faculty, staff, and student environment or commitment to do so as a faculty member at VCU.

University Counseling Services has an APA-accredited pre-doctoral intern training program. The multidisciplinary staff of UCS includes fourteen full-time clinicians and a graduate training staff drawing from the disciplines of psychology, social work, and psychiatry. VCU is a growing urban university of 30,000 students located on two campuses in the capital city of Richmond, VA.

The position is open until filled and initial application review will begin June 14, 2015. Salary is commensurate with experience and includes a comprehensive benefits package.
